Disabled Veterans Outreach Program

(DVOP) Specialist provides case management to veterans with barriers to employment. The Disabled Veterans Case Manager works with clients to:

- Complete a Comprehensive
 Assessment: evaluating their employment barriers, job history, current skills, and education.
- Create and follow an Employment Plan: capturing the client's career goals, steps to achieve them, barriers to be overcome, and agreed upon actions to be taken by the client and specialist.
- Maintain regular contact (1-2 weeks minimum).

Local Veterans Employment

Representative (LVER) works directly with local employers to facilitate hiring Veterans. Their outreach to the employer community focuses on facilitating employment, training, and placement services. They advocate to employers on behalf of job ready Veterans and eligible spouses/caregivers.
